Entry Procedure for Nightingale Exeter UltraSound Clinic

- Parking is at Osprey House (opposite The Nightingale Hospital). Please allow plenty of time for your journey, as we will be extremely unlikely to see anyone arriving late.
- 10 mins prior to your appointment please go to Nightingale Security Gate – please wear a mask. They will complete a temperature check and Track and Trace details will be taken.
- Follow the “Ultrasound Clinic” signs up the 2nd ramp into the building, and turn left, again following the signs. Pass through the double doors into the waiting room.
- Wash your hands and take a seat.
- Make yourself known to the clinical staff that regularly check the room for new entrants. Please note – there is no reception desk or administrative staff.
- Exit is via a one-way system leading you back outside to the large ramp you entered by.

Please come alone into the Nightingale Hospital site wherever possible and wear a mask. If you are unable to do this, please contact us so we can discuss options.

Mobility

If you use a walking aid, we recommend that you bring it with you, as there is an approximately 400m walk, including an 80m steady ramp, from the Security Gate to the Poppy Ward. If you are unable to walk this alone, you will be able to bring a chaperone to escort you to the waiting room. Please notify us of this during your triage call in the days leading up to your appointment.

Unfortunately, we are unable to accommodate patients requiring Ambulance Transport – please call us as soon as possible so we can make alternative arrangements for you.

We will call you in the days prior to your appointment to triage you for Covid19 symptoms and answer any questions you may have.
